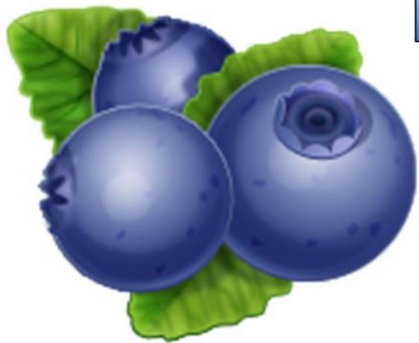

Thank you.

## MEGA PASS POLICY

Before a Mega Pass holder can ride the rides, they must redeem their pass at a designated ticket booth **each day**. This booth will have a banner stating "Redeem Mega Pass Here." The attendant will then punch the day on the pass and the pass holder will have a wristband applied to their wrist. This wristband must be worn and allows the Mega Pass holder to ride the rides for that day only. This must be done each day they attend.
