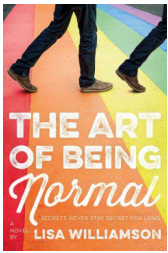
THE DARKEST PART OF THE FOREST by Holly Black

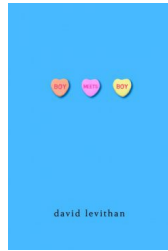
I'LL GIVE YOU THE SUN by Jandy Nelson

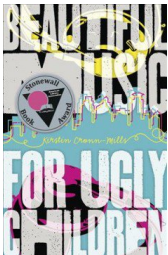
BOY MEETS BOY by David Levithan

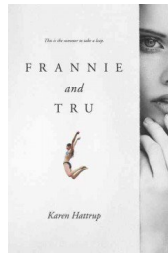
IT LOOKS LIKE THIS by Rafi Mittlefehldt

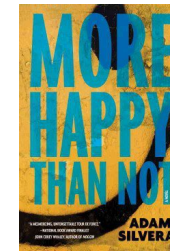
BEAUTIFUL MUSIC FOR UGLY CHILDREN by Kirstin Cronn-Mills

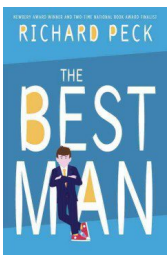
FRANNIE AND TRU by Karen Hatstrup

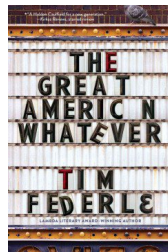
MORE HAPPY THAN NOT by Adam Silvera

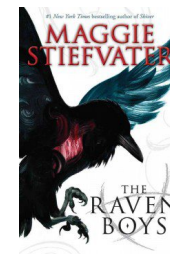
THE BEST MAN by Richard Peck

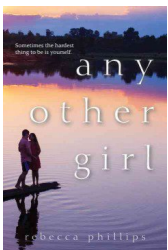
THE GREAT AMERICAN WHATEVER by Tim Federle

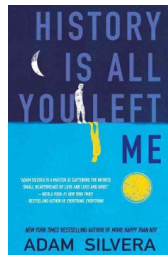
THE RAVEN BOYS by Maggie Stiefvater

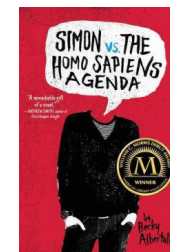
ANY OTHER GIRL by Rebecca Phillips
