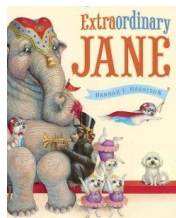

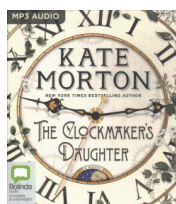
Extraordinary Jane

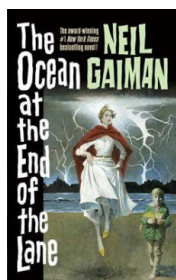
The clockmaker's daughter

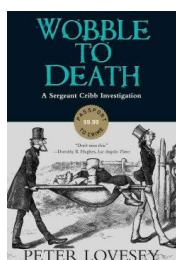


The ocean at the end of the lane

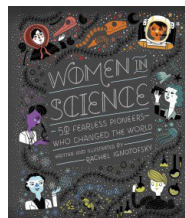


Wobble to death : an Inspector Cribb investigation

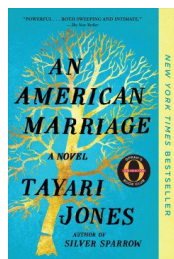


Women in science : 50 fearless pioneers who changed the world

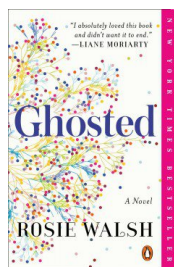


An American marriage

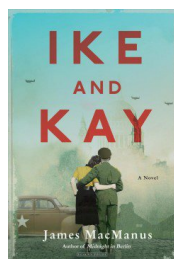


Ghosted
