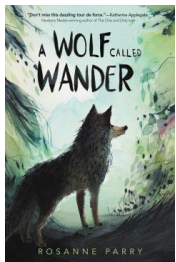

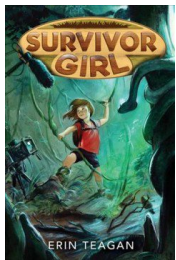


A Wolf Called Wander

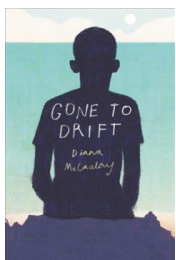


Story Thieves

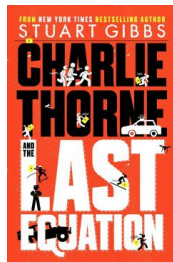


Gone to Drift

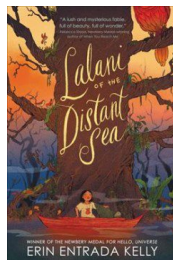


Charlie Thorne and the Last Equation

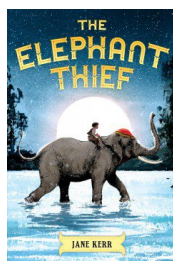


Lalani of the Distant Sea

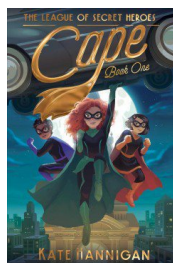


The Elephant Thief

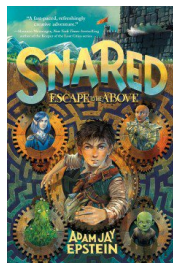


Cape

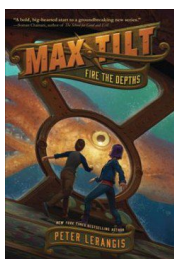

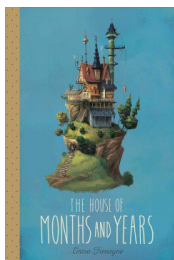

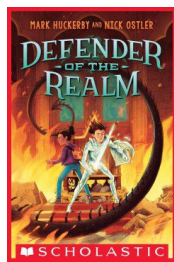


Orphan Island

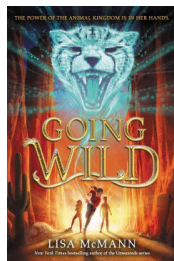


A World Below

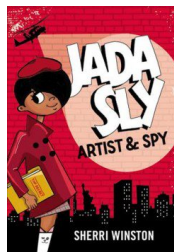
