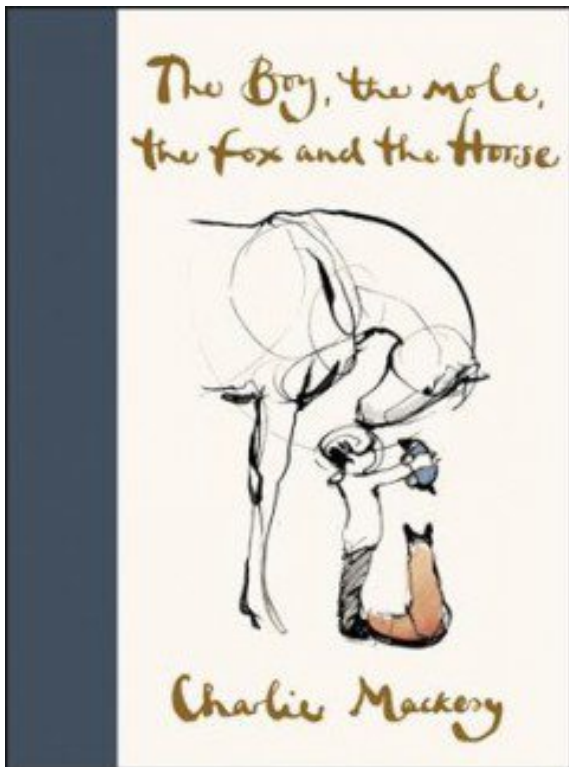


# Teen Book Reviews



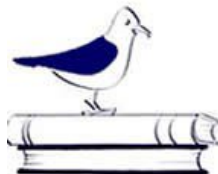
## The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse
