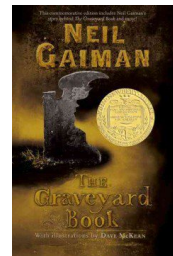

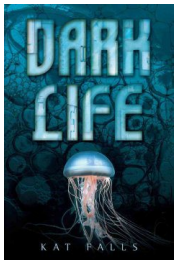


The Graveyard Book

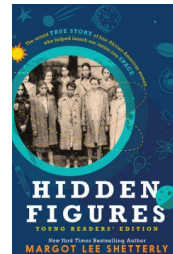

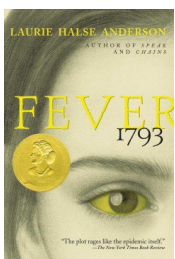

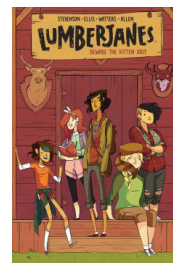


Fever, 1793

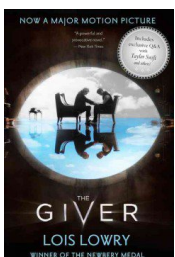

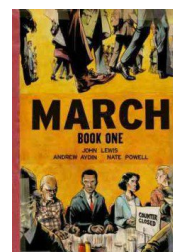

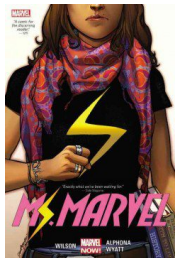

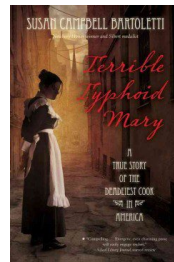

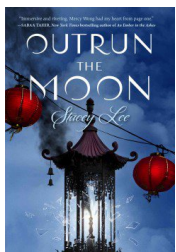

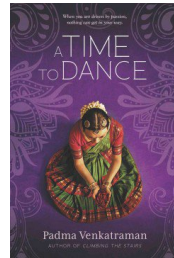

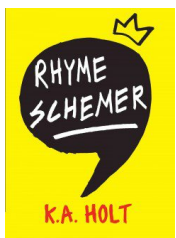

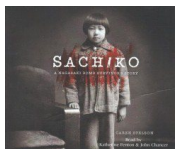


The Wee Free Men (Series)

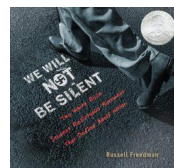
