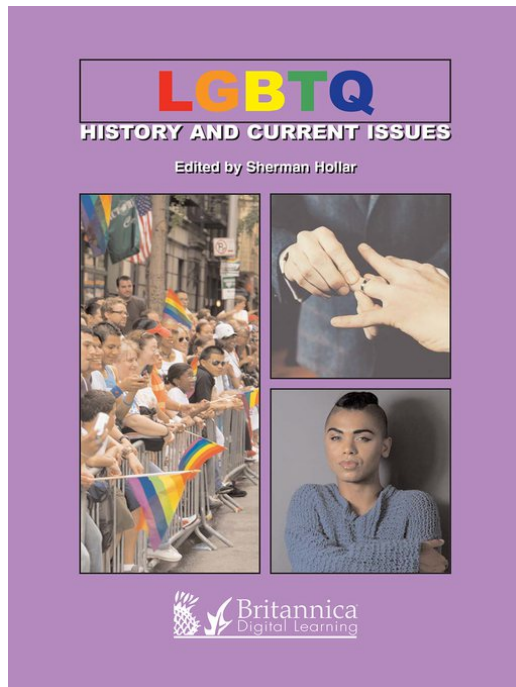

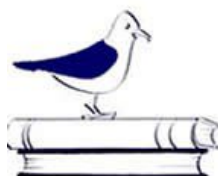
LGBTQ History and Current Issues
