Program Guidelines

This is a progressive reading program with reading incentives. Children participating should be in sixth grade or below. Books will be entered into Beanstack, an online reading log accessible from the library website, which will allow participants to read and complete challenges to earn raffle tickets for prizes. They may also utilize a [Book Bingo](#) format for raffle tickets instead.

Pre-schoolers may have books read to them. If older siblings read to younger family members, the books read may be counted by both of them.

If children read books which are at least 100 pages long, every 50 pages will count as one book once the entire book is read. Books which are read for school can be counted both for the school and the public library summer reading program.

Students in the Stoughton schools who participate via Beanstack or Book Bingo, we will share their name and grade with the School system to let them know they participated in the Summer Reading Program.
