**Monday, June 15, 2020 ~ Friday, August 14, 2020**

- Anyone 18 years of age or older may participate in the Adult Summer Reading Challenge.
- You will receive one (1) raffle entry for each Bingo of 5 tasks completed. Maximum 5 Bingos (raffle entries) per person.
- A Bingo may be any row, column, or diagonal.
- Books must be a minimum of 100 pages (or the equivalent in alternate formats).
- Each task on this game card must be fulfilled by a different book or activity.
- You can report a bingo on your card by email (eglibraryinfo@eglibrary.org), phone (518-477-7476), or, if current health regulations allow, in person.
- Raffle prize categories will be announced by August 1 on the library website and on our social media.
- One Summer Reading Challenge per person. You may participate with either this Bingo card or online through Beanstalk, not both. (See more about Beanstalk in the next column).
- All Bingos MUST be reported, and raffle tickets submitted, by 5:30 pm on Friday, August 14, 2020.
- Summer reading works under the honor system. A rule of thumb: if it feels like cheating, it probably is!
- This game card was created in May, while the library building was closed and public safety recommendations changed regularly. The availability of assistance and prizes are subject to change as the situation requires. While we will do our best to make this an exciting and fulfilling Summer Reading Challenge, please be patient with us if changes are necessary.
