The Teen Advisory Group (TAG) is Williamsburg Regional Library's volunteer group for ages 13-18. Group members meet to share ideas for teen library services and materials and complete a variety of service tasks.

Tasks will include:

Requirements

- Submit an application with a parent's permission indicating "Teen Advisory Group" as your area of interest; Online applications can be accessed from the Volunteer link at wrl.org/teens.
- Application deadlines for the 2020-2021 school year are **September 15** (for Fall start) and **January 15** (for February start).
- You must attend a 45 minute orientation on Zoom prior to participating.
- Work positively and respectfully in a group with library staff and teens
- Commit to improve how the library serves teens, and help promote the library to other teens.
- A minimum 6 months' commitment is appreciated
