

WWBIC has supported Kiva since 2015, both through lending and program support. Join the crowd. Kiva believes in character over credit and the power of community-based lending. Kiva provides funding opportunities for entrepreneurs where conventional lenders won't.

In 2019, Kiva Wisconsin provided 61 microloans to small businesses across the state. Lended dollars totaled over \$379,000. Of the 61 businesses that received a Kiva microloan, 73% were woman-owned businesses, and 60% were minority-owned businesses.
