## BINARY CDDE BRACELETS INSTUCTIONS \& SIMPLE BINARY NUMBER CHART

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Choose 3 colors of beads: 1 color for your 1s, 1 color for your 0s, and another color for a spacer.
2. Use the binary chart to create the numbers for your bracelet. To make it easier for little kids we are using a simplified chart with only numbers 0-9. You can add the code for 1 and 2 to make twelve. $01+10=0110$. You can also download the more advanced chart of numbers 1-31 and one for letters if you child wants a challenge.
3. Tie a knot at one end of the string. Lace the string with the beads, putting the spacer bead between each number. Tie ends together to make your bracelet!
