

Volunteers Needed to Manage Rocky Hill Community Fund

In 2019, The Hartford Foundation for Public Giving established a \$100,000 community fund for each of the twenty-nine (29) towns in the Foundation's geographic region, which includes the Town of Rocky Hill. This fund is targeted to support residents in taking ownership of the town's needs that are not traditionally funded by the Town government.

In order to allocate this grant, there needs to be an Advisory Committee that is inclusive and reflective of all of the town's residents. The Advisory Committee will identify community needs that will be beneficial to a majority of Rocky Hill's residents.

To be eligible to serve on the Advisory Committee, you must:

1. Be a resident of Rocky Hill
2. Not serve as a current elected official of Rocky Hill
3. Be at least fourteen (14) years old
