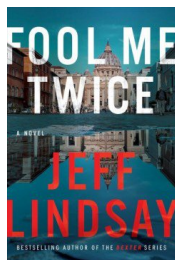


Fool Me Twice

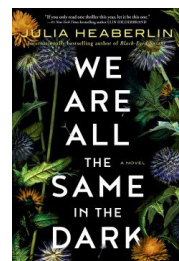
Strike Me Down

secrets.



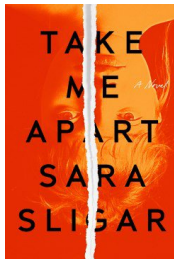

Hour of the Assassin

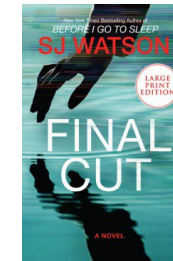

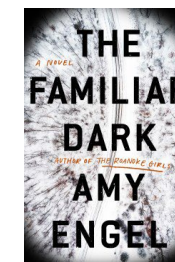
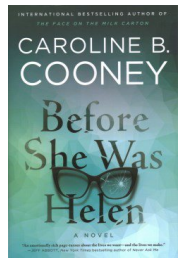
