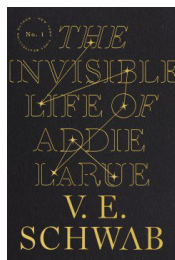

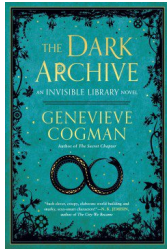

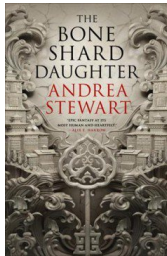


The Dark Archive

Library's future.

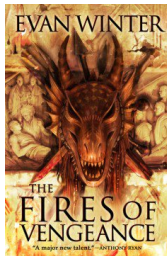


The Bone Shard Daughter

Her father's mastery of bone shard magic has maintained law and order in the kingdom for many years, but with the threat of revolution, his daughter, who has

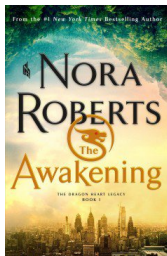
been trapped in the palace, is determined to learn the secret of the magic to claim her birthright and save the kingdom.

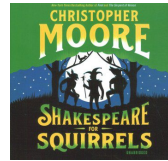


The Awakening

alternate world.

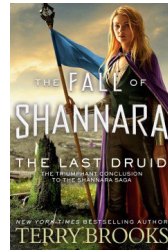


Shakespeare for Squirrels

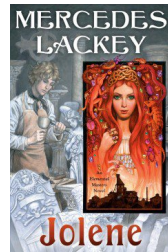


The Last Druid

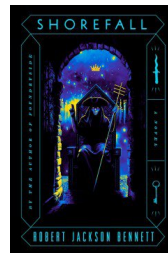
in a deadly realm.

by Mercedes Lackey

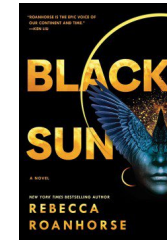

by Robert Jackson Bennett

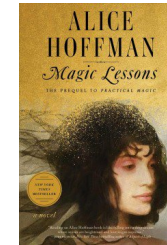

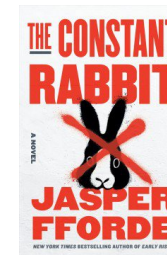
before cursing her own family in love.
