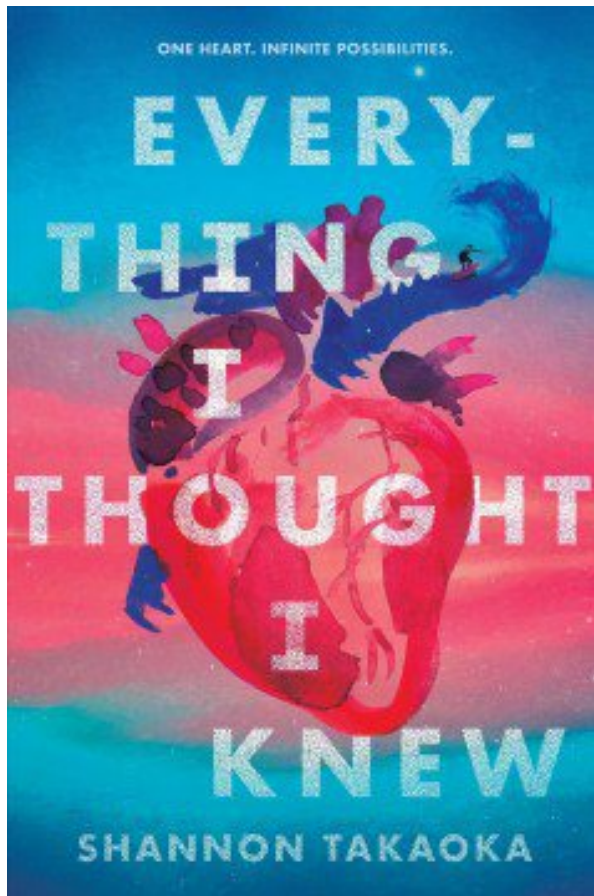


# Teen Book Reviews

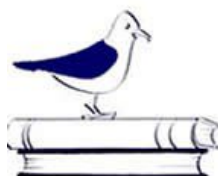


Everything I thought I knew
