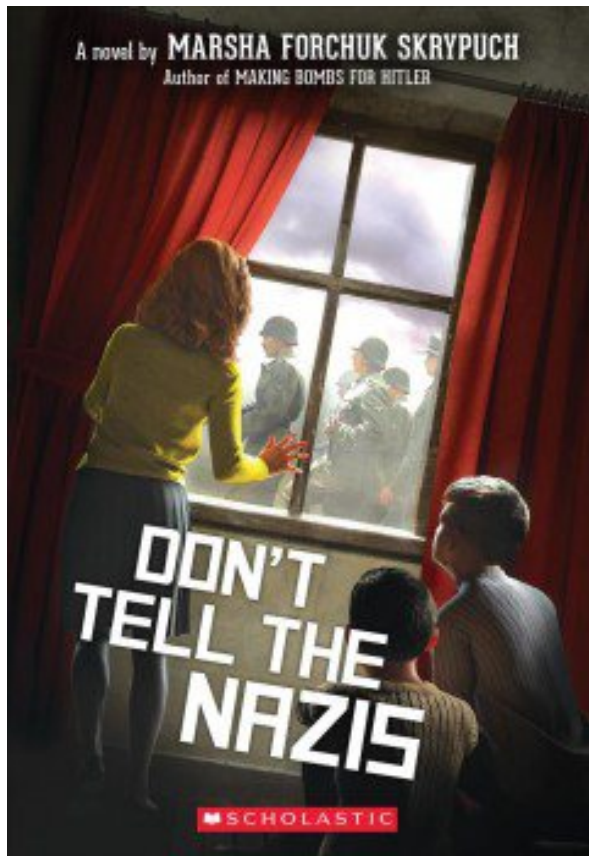

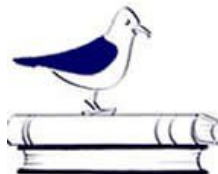


Don't tell the Nazis : a novel
