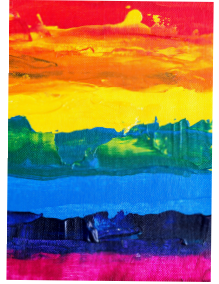
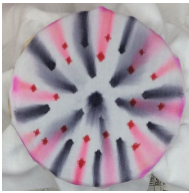
Kit 1) Hack-an-Egg: kit includes plastic eggs, an LED tea light, and assorted materials
