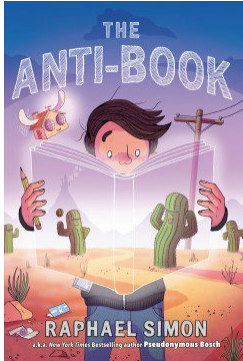


The Lion of Mars

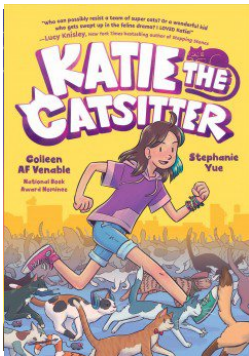


The Anti-Book

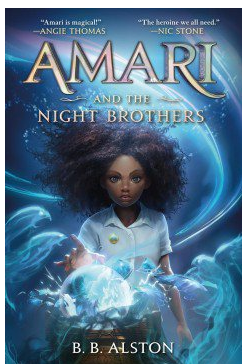


Katie the Catsitter

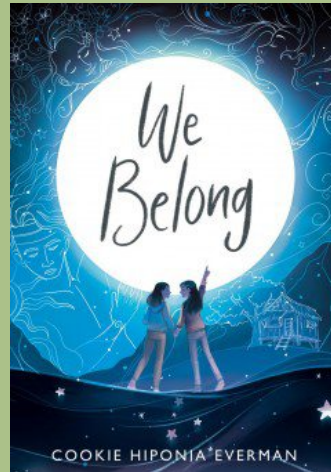


Amari and the Night Brothers

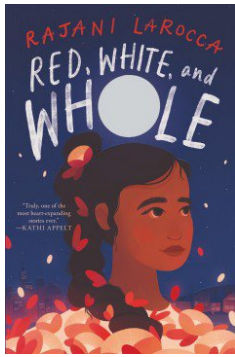

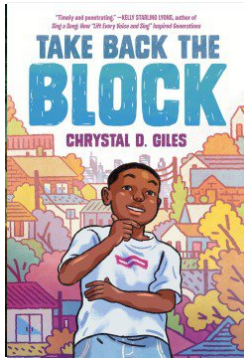


Red, White, and Whole

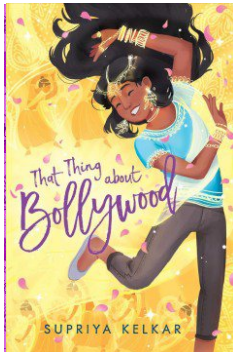


Take Back the Block

Sixth grader Wes Henderson sets out to save the Oaks, a neighborhood where he has lived his whole life, from being sold to a real estate developer.

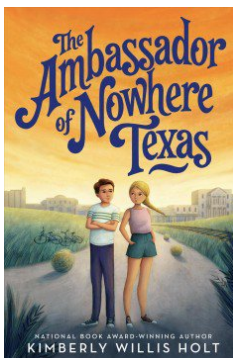

Middle schooler Sonali cannot bring herself to share her feelings, wakes up one day and involuntarily bursts into Bollywood song and dance routines.

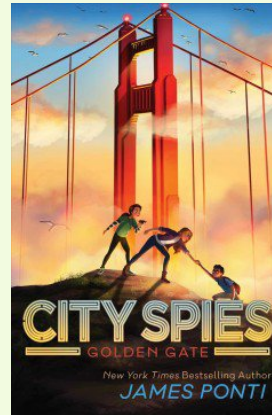


The Ambassador of Nowhere Texas

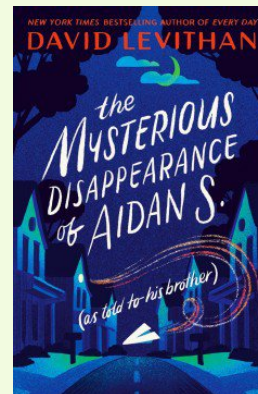


City Spies-Golden Gate

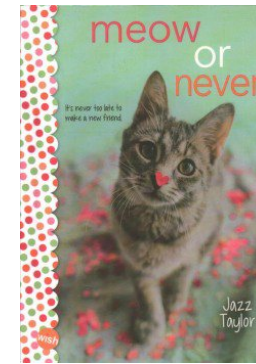

Aidan disappeared for six days. Then just as suddenly as he disappeared, he reappears. The story he tells is impossible, but Aidan is sticking to it.

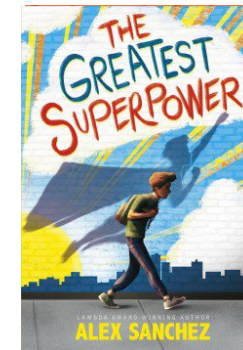


Meow or Never

Avery Williams can sing but that doesn't mean she can sing in front of people. She likes to stay backstage at her new school, which is where she finds a cat tucked away in a nook.

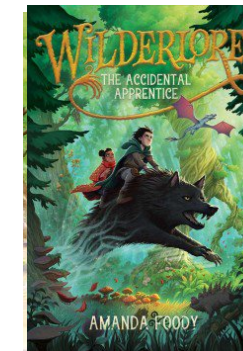

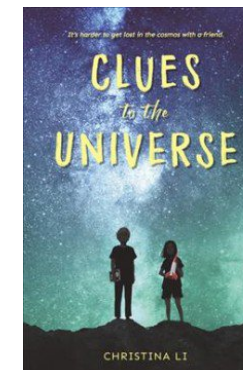


Accidental Apprentice
