
BOOK ADVENTURE: EXPLORE NATURE


Take a hike. Visit one of the many hiking trails in Massachusetts State Parks.


Keep track. Borrow a <u>Birdwatching Backpack</u> or <u>Leaf Identification Kit</u> from your Library and start an urban nature journal.
