


BOOK ADVENTURE: EXPLORE HIDDEN HISTORIES


Take a class. Study the readings and discussion topics for an American history class through MIT's OpenCourseWare.


Go on a history hunt. Use <u>this guide</u> to find the historical markers in your neighborhood and learn about the people, places and events they represent.
