by Anthony Horowitz

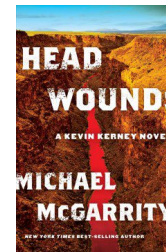

by Val McDermid

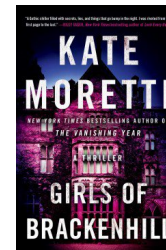
