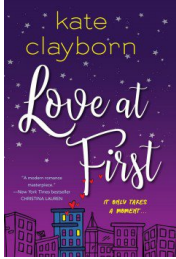

by Kate Clayborn

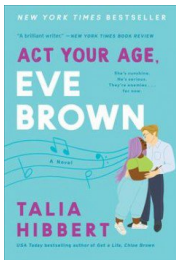

by Talia Hibbert

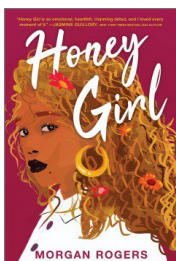

by Meghan Quinn

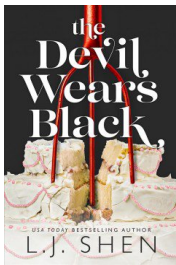

by Morgan Rogers

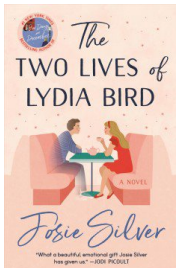

by L. J. Shen

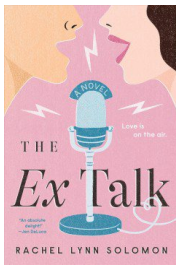

by Rachel Lynn Solomon

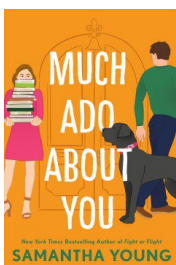

by Sophie Sullivan

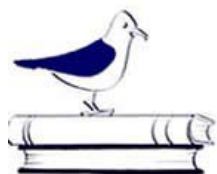
