Celano, Marianne Something Happened in Our Town: A Child's Story About Racial Injustice JNonfiction - 305.896073 CELA **Grades K+**

Reasons: Challenged for "divisive language" and because it was thought to promote antipolice views



Anderson, Laurie Halse Speak Teen Fiction - Grades 8+

Asher, Jay

Banned, challenged, and restricted because it was thought to contain a political viewpoint and it was claimed to be biased against male students, and for the novel's inclusion of rape and profanity.



for LGBTQIA+ content, conflicting with a religious viewpoint, and not reflecting "the values of our community." (Recently retitled






13 Reasons Why Teen Fiction - Grades 9+ Reasons: banned, challenged, and restricted for addressing teen suicide



Haack, Daniel Prince & Knight JEasy - Grades K+

Reasons: challenged and restricted for featuring a gay marriage and LGBTQIA+ content; for being "a deliberate attempt to indoctrinate young children" with the potential to cause confusion, curiosity, and gender dysphoria; and for conflicting with a religious viewpoint.



Reynolds, Jason All American Bovs Teen Fiction - Grades 8+

Reasons: Banned and challenged for profanity, drug use, and alcoholism, and because it was thought to promote antipolice views, contain divisive topics, and be "too much of a sensitive matter right now."



Pilkey, Dav Captain Underpants series JFiction - Grades 2+

Reasons: series was challenged because it was perceived as encouraging disruptive behavior, while Captain Underpants and the Sensational Saga of Sir Stinks-A-Lot was challenged for including a same-sex couple.



Tamaki, Mariko This One Summer **Teen Fiction - Grades 8+**

Reasons: banned and challenged for profanity, sexual references, and certain illustrations
