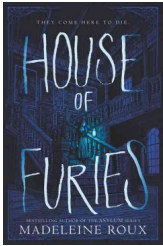

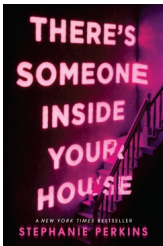

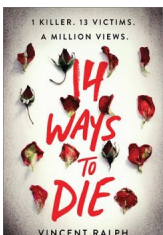
charismatic leader named Dr. Imogen Moran.

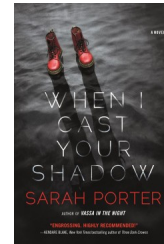

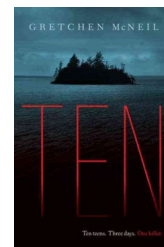

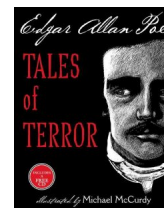
