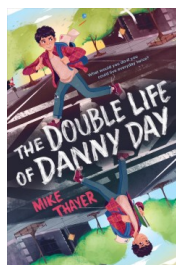
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Yusuf Azeem is Not a Hero

by Delilah S. Dawson

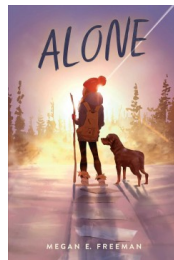

by Claire M. Andrews

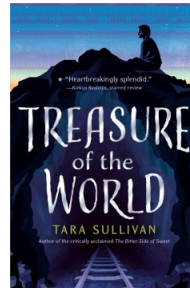

by Greg Van Eekhout

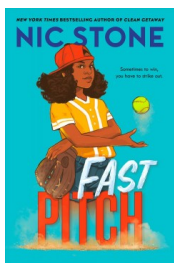
