Library Membership

Free Library Memberships are available to all residents of the Township of Tay, including: seasonal residents; those who own/operate a business in Tay; those who work in Tay; and any children attending school in Tay.



Borrowing Library Materials

You can access our collection online or stop in during our open hours to browse the shelves - the online catalogue contains materials from all three Tay township Public Library branches. You can access your account on our website (tay.library.on.ca) or by using the mobile app (Simcoe County Libraries) to view your checkout history, renew your items, view fines, see when your items are due, and more!

Loan Periods & Overdue Fines

Tay Township Public Library cardholders are able to checkout a maximum of 30 (thirty) items - this includes a maximum of 5 electronic* items and 3 magazines.

Loan Periods:

3 week loans - books, audiobooks & bookpacks.

1 week loans - magazines, DVDs/BluRays, Launchpads & Video Games. Overdue Fines:

.25¢ per day (per item) - books & audiobooks, bookpacks, puzzles, non-electronic materials.

\$1 per day (per item) - DVDs/BluRays, Launchpad tablets, video games.

Holds

You may place holds on items that are not currently available for checkout - when the item becomes available, you will receive a notice from staff (via email or phone call).

If holds are not picked up within a certain time limit, the materials will be returned to the shelves for circulation.

Renewals

Library items may be renewed up to 2 (two) times provided there are no holds/patrons waiting for it - this can be done over the phone, by email, in-person at your branch, or via social media message. You can renew items on your own using the library website or mobile app.

Reciprocal Borrowing

If you are currently a member in good standing at the Midland Public Library, you are entitled to a free Tay Township Public Library Membership as well. You must bring your MPL card and a valid piece of ID, as well as come during both libraries open hours so we can verify your card.

Interlibrary Loans

If we don't have the title you're looking for, we can request it through Interlibrary Loan (ILLO) from another library in the province - these books arrive by mail and cannot be renewed.
