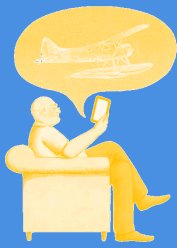

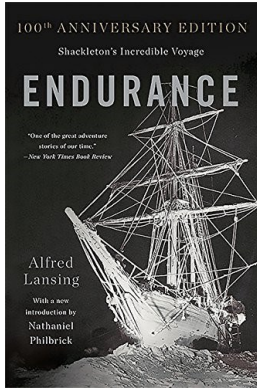

Join us for a discussion about Shackleton's heroic and miraculous voyage into Antarctica.

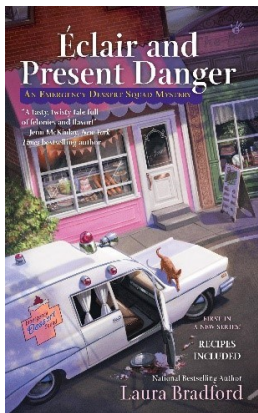

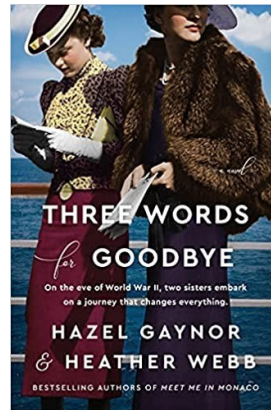

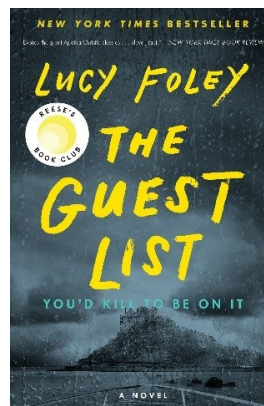
