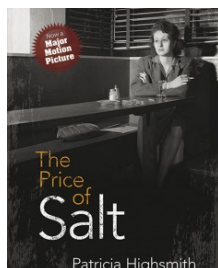

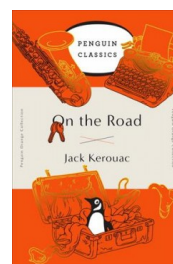
*Next Stop Love*, by Rachel Stockbridge

Communting & Romance all in one book!



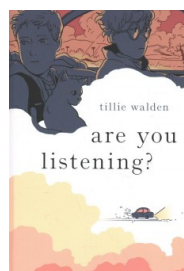
*The Price of Salt*, by Patricia Highsmith

Published in 1952, still a classic love story on the open road.



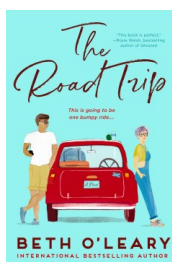
*On The Road*, by Jack Kerouac

Mom road trips across a country new to her with two strangers to find her estranged child.



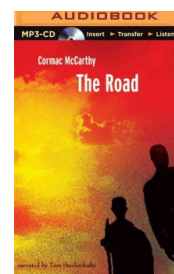
*One of the Good Ones*, by Maika and Maritza Moulite

Cousins on a road trip to Pride dive into family secrets and friendships



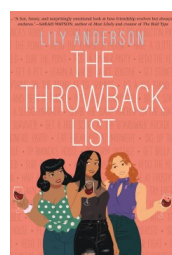
*The Road*, by Cormac McCarthy

Explores the tenderness that keeps two people alive in the face of total devastation



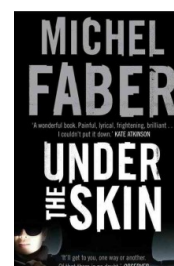
*The Stand*, by Stephen King

The Road Trip to end all road trips. The audiobook version is perfect if you spend a lot of time in traffic.



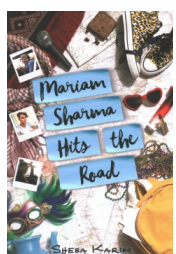
*The Throwback List*, by Lily Anderson

An unexpected trip back home, the land that time forgot.



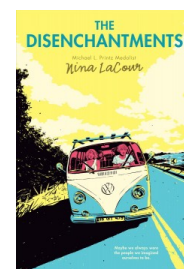
*Under the Skin*, by Michel Faber

Just another reason not to hitch hike.



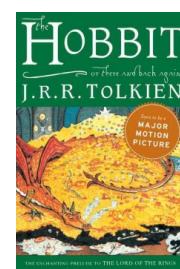
*Mariam Sharma Hits the Road*, by Sheba Karim

College buddies road trip to New Orleans.



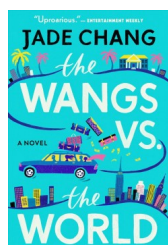
*The Disenchantments*, by Nina LaCour
