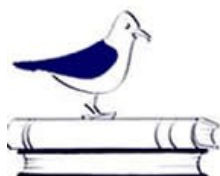

**Thursday, May 19, 6:00 pm**



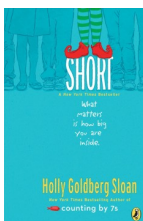
If you like to read, play trivia, and win, then this program may be for you! Join us and find out what books we will be reading this summer.
