
### **Book Discussion: Women Around the World Book Series: Mournable Body by Tsitsi Dangarembga**

Registration begins 12/20/2022.




### **Book Discussion: The Radium Girls: The Dark Story of America's Shining Women by Kate Moore**

Registration is required and opens on 12/15/2023.




### **Book Discussion: True Crime Series: American Predator: The Hunt for the Most Meticulous Serial Killer of the 21st Century**
