

Brother PE800 Embroidery Machine

Quick Guide

Supplies needed to use Embroidery Machine

- Brother PE800 Machine
- White Embroidery Thread
- Additional Embroidery thread of your color choice
- Preselected design uploaded to USB OR choice of preloaded designs



1. Plug the machine into the wall with the provided cable. Turn on machine by turning the switch to "on"
 - At this time, the embroidery machine arm will move. DO NOT TOUCH it at this time, it is simply setting itself up for use.

2. Create a bobbin of white under-layer, and insert into proper enclosure

3. Depending on the size of the embroidery, select the correct hoop size



4. Remove the top part of the hoop. Place in your stabilizer. Add your fabric over the stabilizer. Secure with top part of hoop and tighten lower screw for better support. Slide this under your needle and attach to the embroidery arm on the machine.

5. Select the design you wish to embroider OR upload from a USB drive.

6. Based on the design, select your first thread color and thread the machine.

7. Click on "Embroidery" button on the touch screen. Once the light above the needle glows green, you are good to go.

8. Press the button and the machine will stitch the first color.



9. Once the color is completed, remove from thread stand, and rethread the machine with your next color. Continue until all layers and colors are completed.

10. When your project is done, unhook the hoop from the embroidery machine arm. Remove the top section of the hoop and remove your embroidered item.



11. At this point, you can remove any excess stabilizing material and threads that you may not want to see.
