Hoopla FAQ's

What's the difference between a hold and a request? To place a "hold" on an item is to be placed on a wait list for a title that the library owns.

A "request" is to ask the library to consider purchasing a title it does currently own. These titles will show as "not in catalog."

What is a snoozed hold?

If you have entered the grace period of the Reserved hold status, you may Snooze the hold if not ready for the title.

Snoozing a hold simply allows you to delays your hold 48 hours. After the delay you will then have the option to check out, snooze, or cancel the hold.

There is not a limit to the number of times you may Snooze a title. The snooze will end after the allotted time, please do not cancel the snooze, or you will lose the hold.

If I can't find a book I'm looking for, can I recommend a book be added to hoopla?

Submitting a Title Request within the hoopla app (or hoopla site) is a way that you can recommend we add specific titles to the collection.

Requests are limited to three requests per person at a time.

Although we strive to honor requests, purchases are based on multiple factors including budget, date of publication, popularity, and demand.



Hoopla Flex is an expanded version of Hoopla that features new and popular eBook and audiobook titles offered alongside their existing 1.1 million "instant" titles.

Quick tip!

Check the icons of the title to know if it's a Flex or Instant borrow.



Beaufort County Library customers can have **5 Flex titles** checked out at one time.

Unlike Instant titles, only one person at a time may borrow a Flex title. If a title is currently out on loan, you may place a hold on the title.



Beaufort County Library customers get **8 instant borrows per month.** Instant titles are always available and can be used by multiple customers.

Unused Instant borrows will not roll over into the next month and returning an Instant title will not free up an additional Instant borrow.
