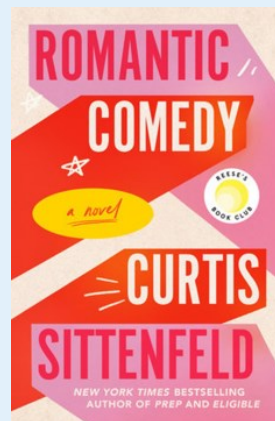

by Nikki Erlick

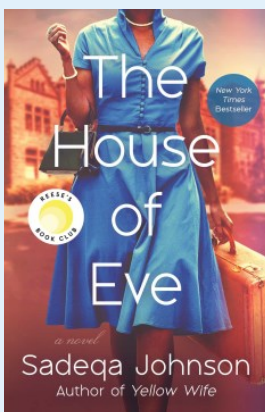

by Curtis Sittenfeld

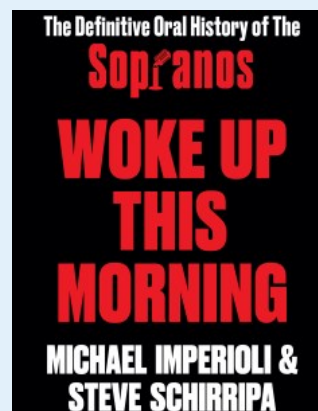
