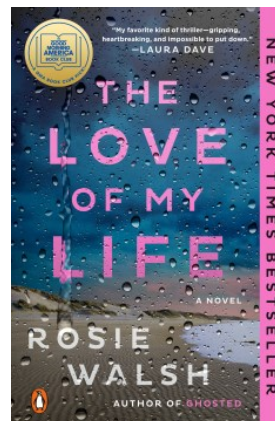
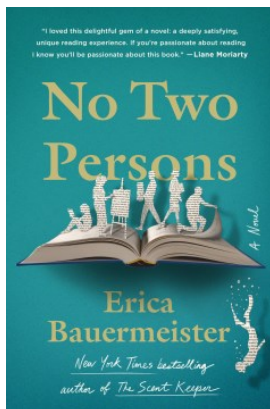

The Love of My Life

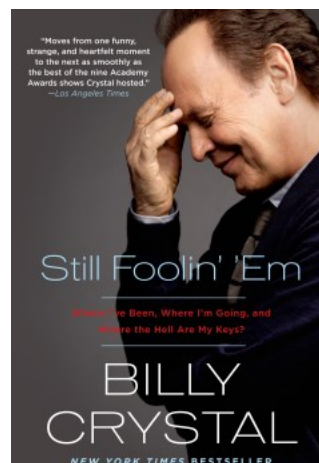
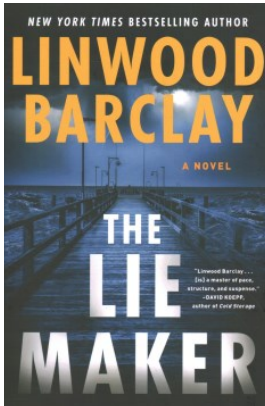
