- Consumer Reports is an expert, independent, non-profit organization that provides reviews, ratings, recommendations, and comparisons of consumer products or services.
- Access to their online reviews are available for free from Middlesex County Library; all you need is your library card




where do I find Consumer Reports?

- Access Consumer Reports by visiting our [Learning and Research](#) page. From the website click on the light blue **Learning & Research** button and look for the Consumer Reports icon.
- If you are not in the library you will need to enter your library card number and pin (usually the last four digits of your phone number).

searching with Consumer Reports

- Search for a product name or type using the search box
- Or browse an A-Z index for a full list of product types
- Each product category provides the user with an Overview, Ratings, Recommended, and Buying Guide

All Products A-Z



- To compare models, go to the Ratings page and click the **plus sign** next to each model you wish to compare. Once selected, click compare on the top left of the page. You can select up to 3 products to compare at one time.



Consumer Reports magazine

- To view the current issue or back issues of the magazine, scroll to the very bottom of the page and look for the **Magazines & Books** menu
- Back issues are available back to 2012. The past 5 years are indexed and the index can be accessed by clicking **5 Year Index**.
