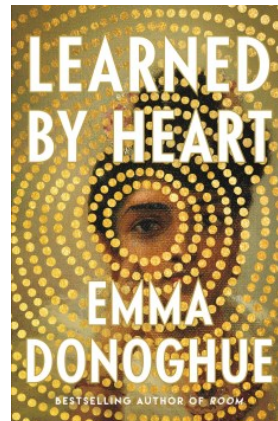

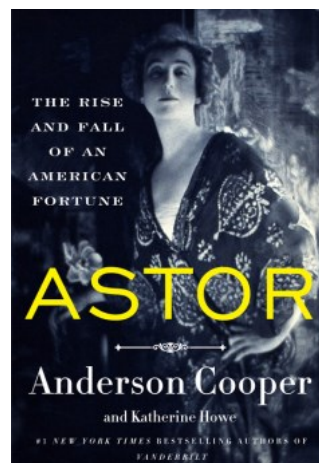
**How Can I Help You**
