

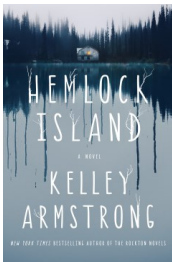
### Burn the Negative

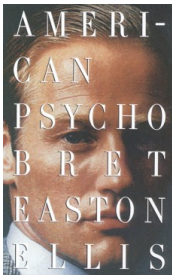


### Hemlock Island

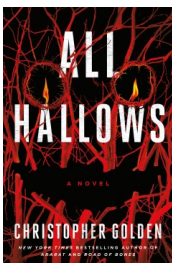


### American Psycho

In a black satire of the '80s, a decade of naked greed and unparalleled callousness, a successful Wall Street yuppie cannot get enough of anything—including murder.

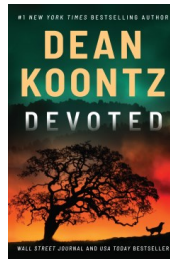


### All Hallows

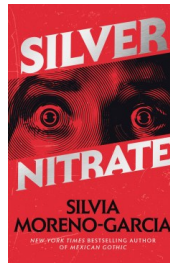


### Devoted

A child who has not spoken since his father's death befriends a dog who understands him, but the situation is complicated by an evil force that is targeting his family.

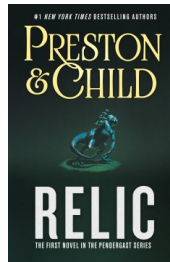


### Silver Nitrate

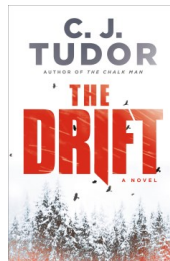


### Relic

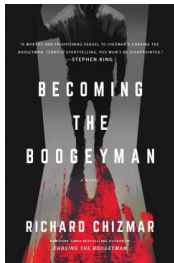

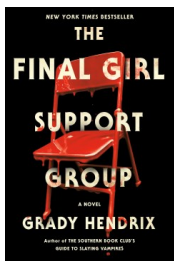


## Becoming the Boogeyman

After making a successful true crime writing and filmmaking career revolving around the murders that shook his hometown decades earlier, Rich is terrified when the killings begin again.

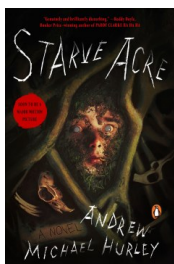


## The Final Girl Support Group

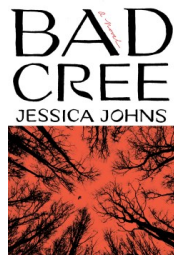


## Blood Country

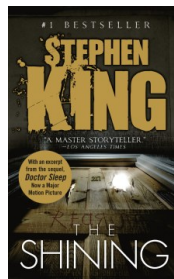


## Bad Cree

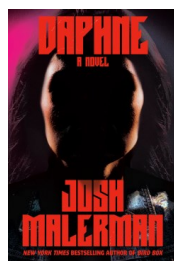


## A Black and Endless Sky

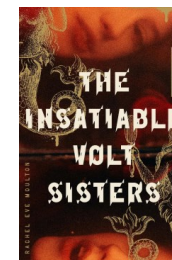


## The Children on the Hill
