A collection of stories that span the time when humans live in a world without hunger, disease, or death and Scythes act as the living instruments of population control.



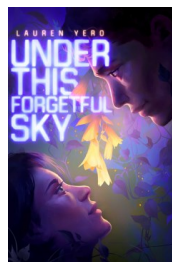
The Last Saxon King

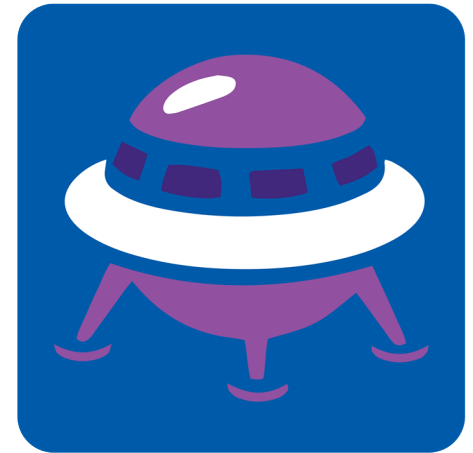

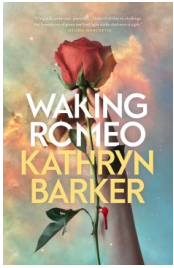

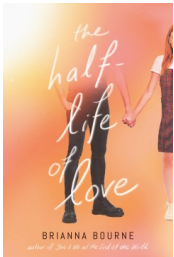


Waking Romeo

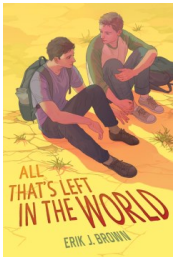


The Half-Life of Love

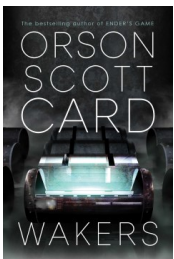


All That's Left in the World

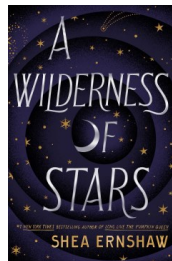


The Kindred

A high school junior teams up with a hacker during a police brutality protest to shut down a device that creates an impenetrable dome around Baltimore that is keeping the residents in and information from going out.

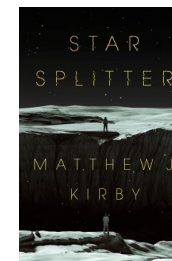


Queen's Hope
