
<u>A Hundred Horses by Sarah</u> Lean

Snow Foal by Susanna Bailey



War Horse by Michael Morpurgo


Joey the horse recalls his experiences growing up on an English farm, his struggle for survival as a cavalry horse during World War I, and his reunion with his beloved master.

Ride On by Faith Erin Hicks


