Programs & Events

Take & Make (Monthly)

Take & Makes are a project to bring home. You can find our Take & Makes in the Children's room starting at 9am on the day they are advertised, while supplies last! **First come, first served.**

Baby Storytime

Join us in this librarian led story time for **babies 0 - 12** months old and their caregivers. Come prepared to move around and play with your baby!

Toddler Storytime

This lively librarian led weekly storytime is for **13-months to 2 years** old and their caregivers. We'll read stories, sing songs, and move around! This program encourages early literacy and social interaction through listening, movement, singing and play.

Preschool Storytime

This fast paced librarian led storytime is for **3-5 year olds** and their caregivers. This program encourages early literacy and social interaction through imagination, repetition, movement and socialization.

Lego Club

This family event is best for **supervised children over 3 years old**. **No registration necessary.**

Story & Craft

This story and craft time is for our young friends! We'll read a special story and create a very simple related craft. This program is best for children **ages 1-5 and their carevigers.**

Lego for Littles

Come to the library to play with Duplos! This casual event is best for supervised children 3 years old and under. This is a drop in program for children and their caregivers. Adult supervision is required at all times. **This program is intended for supervised children 5 years and under.**

Read to Rocko

Stop by from 6:15-7:15 pm as we welcome Rocko and his owner Kim!! This program allows each child to have a 15 minute one-on-one session with Rocko! Children can pick a favorite book from home or the children's room. **Spots are filled on a first come first served basis.**

Pokemon Appreciation Day

We're changing up our Pokemon Club! Children of all ages and their caregivers can join us for a Pokemon Appreciation program! We'll have a simple Pokemon art or craft, a themed game, and space for kids to show off their own cards, trade, or battle if they want to. We encourage everyone to bring in their Pokemon cards - and only their cards that they want others to look at or to trade - but it is not required! **Please note that caregivers are expected to stay at this event with their child.**

Mad Science- Don't Try This at Home

We often encourage children to try some of our show experiments at home, but not with this show. Don't Try This at Home has some experiments that are not appropriate for children to do or require exotic chemicals. Life Sciences - All About Animals brings children into the amazing animal kingdom! Children learn about diverse, creatures on earth and experiment with camouflage and get hands-on with real tooth and claw replicas. This program has been graciously funded in part by the Mass Cultural Council. **This program is for school** *aged children in grades K-5* and one caregiver per child/family. Registration is required.
