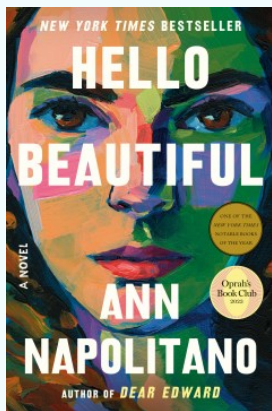

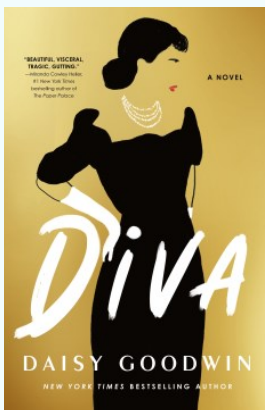

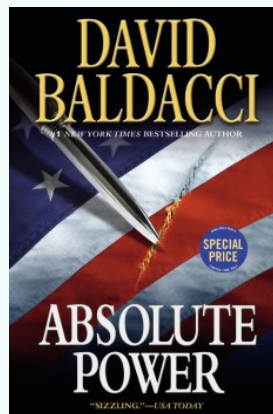
Hello Beautiful
