Programs & Events

Take & Make (Monthly)

Take & Makes are a project to bring home. You can find our Take & Makes in the Children's room starting at 9am on the day they are advertised, while supplies last! **First come, first served.**

Toddler Storytime

This lively librarian led weekly storytime is for **13-months to 2 years** old and their caregivers. We'll read stories, sing songs, and move around! This program encourages early literacy and social interaction through listening, movement, singing and play.

Preschool Storytime

This fast paced librarian led storytime is for **3-5 year olds** and their caregivers. This program encourages early literacy and social interaction through imagination, repetition, movement and socialization.

Elementary Storytime

Join Miss Wendy for a laugh out loud story time geared toward our **friends in K-5** Stories will be followed by some play time.

Lego Club

This family event is best for **supervised children over 3 years old**. **No registration necessary.**

Story & Craft

This story and craft time is for our young friends! We'll read a special story and create a very simple related craft. This program is best for children **ages 1-5 and their carevigers.**

Lego for Littles

This is a drop in program for children and their caregivers. Adult supervision is required at all times. **This program is intended for supervised children 5 years and under.**

Poop Museum

The Poop Museum covers the serious science of poop and pooping, and is delivered with the silliness that you might imagine accompanying a program about poop for young kids. It is the perfect combination of fun, and fabulous, fascinating facts, so that kids (and parents) never forget what they learned.
