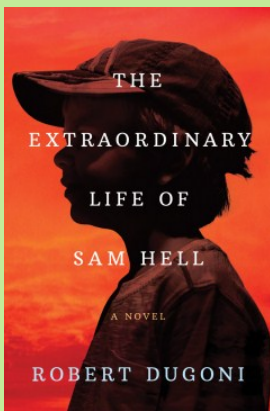

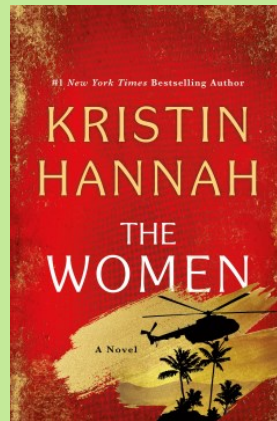

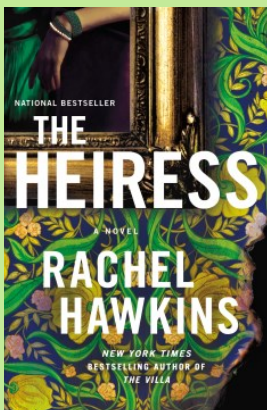
## The Extraordinary Life of Sam Hell

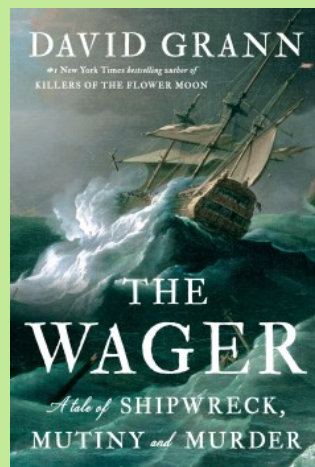
## The Women
