Join your neighbors in April as we read The House of Broken Angels by Luis Alberto Urrea. Valley Reads in the St. Croix Valley is a one book, one community program that brings together residents around a common book. After nine years of NEA Big Read titles, we now are taking a deeper dive into some of the themes, authors and artists that have been featured during the Big Read. This year's programming is focused on themes found in Urrea's work: grief; rituals for marking time; and the borderlands and the Mexican American experience.

Valley Reads is presented by ArtReach St. Croix in conjunction with Valley Bookseller, Stillwater Public Library, and other public libraries located between St. Croix Falls, WI and Hastings, MN.
