

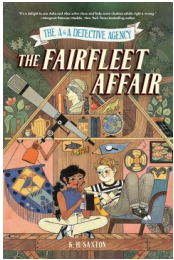

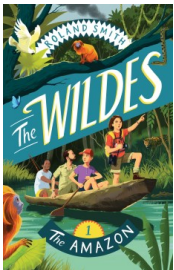


The Fairfleet Affair

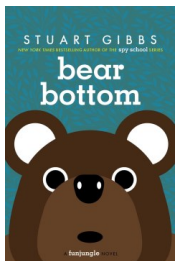
Daybreak on Raven Island

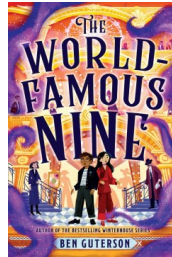

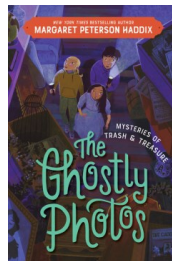
Mr. Lemoncello's Very First Game
