




The Well








The Princess and the Grilled Cheese Sandwich






Afterlove




The Dead and the Dark

New to Snakebite, Oregon, Logan, must figure out who—or what—is haunting the town when teenagers start turning up dead, exposing the dark secrets of those around her.




Darius the Great Is Not Okay




Man O' War

Follow trans teen Noah Byrd as he joins a boyfriend borrowing service—masquerading as an Italian Club—to convince his new classmates he's one of the guys.




The Lesbianna's Guide to Catholic School
