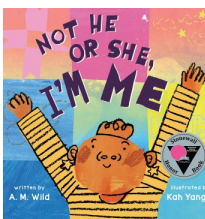

What are Your Words? A Book about Pronouns

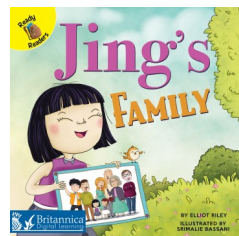

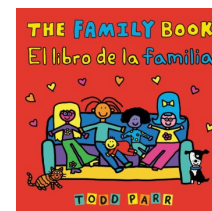

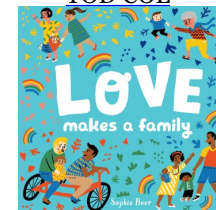
