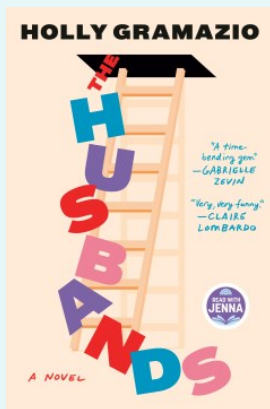

by Holly Gramazio

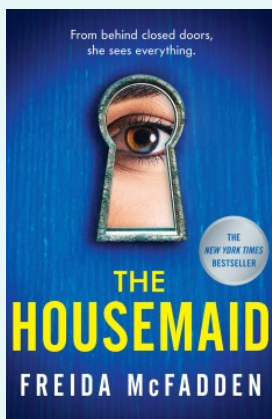
