Join us for an interactive program to learn about the importance of water safety and how to keep you and your family safer in and around water. "It won't happen to you until it does!"



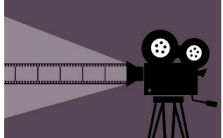
## Camp: Creative Building Corner (a family event)

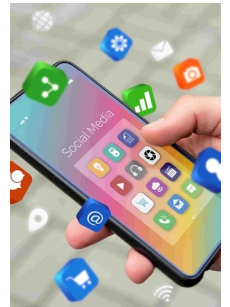
### Tech Help: Book a Librarian Throughout July

Do you have a technology question? Please call 843-849-6161, and speak with someone in the Adult Services Department to schedule a one-on-one appointment with a librarian.



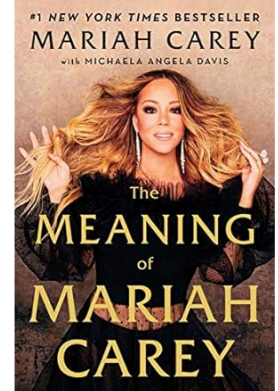
### Finding Popular Sites and Apps

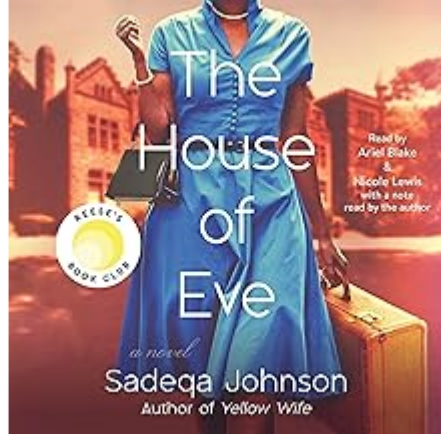
### Mount Pleasant Pop Culture Book Club: The Meaning of Mariah Carey by Mariah Carey

Camping Basics

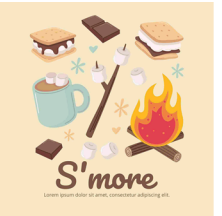

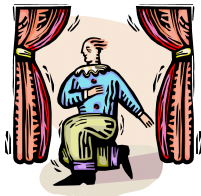


Programs for Children

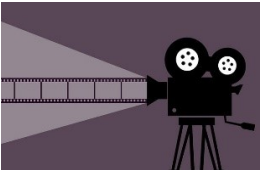
